

N.B: Bidders are required to submit supporting documents to score full point

The minimum qualifying score for functionality is 60 points. Bidders whose score is less than 60 points will not be eligible for further evaluation.

Ugu District Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles whereby a bidder's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the award of points in respect of the tender value and the B-BBEE status of the contributor.

Functionality, Price and Preference will be used for evaluation. The 80/20 preferential point system will be applicable, with 80 points for price and 20 points for B-BBEE Status Level, in terms of revised Preferential Procurement Regulation in effect from 01 April 2017, Gazette Notice No. 40553 dated 20 January 2017. Points to be allocated as follows:
