REQUEST FOR A PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE PROVISION OF JETTING AND SEWAGE VACUUM TANKER SERVICES (VTS) WITHIN UGU DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY-SIX (36) MONTHS

Bids are requested from relevant service providers for the Provision of Jetting and Sewage Vacuum Tanker Services (VTS) within Ugu District Municipality for a Period of Thirty-Six (36) Months.

Bid documents are obtainable from the Ugu District Municipality office in Port Shepstone at No. 28 Connor Street as from **Wednesday, 30 April 2025**, at a non-refundable payment of R1000.00 (No cheques will be accepted). The bid will also be advertised on National Treasury's E Tender portal and the municipality's website where documents can be downloaded free of charge.

Bids completed in accordance with the conditions indicated in documents, must be sealed and endorsed with the relevant contract number and be deposited in the official tender box at the foyer of **Ugu District Municipality at 96 Marine Drive, Oslo Beach, Phase 2**, not later than **12h00 on Friday 30 May 2025**, at which time bids will be opened in public. Bids that are submitted late, incomplete, unsigned or by facsimile, electronically, couriered or not completed in black ink will be rejected and not accepted for further evaluation. Bids submitted are to hold good for a period of **90 days**

A compulsory briefing session will be held at the **Ugu District Municipality Workshop Offices, No. 2 Lind Road, Marburg, 4240 on Friday, 06 May 2025 at 10:00**, bidders who fail to attend this compulsory meeting will not be considered for further evaluation.

Functionality, Price and Preference will be used for evaluation. The 80/20 preferential point system will be applicable, with 80 points for price and 20 points for Specific Goals (*See below table*), in terms of revised Preferential Procurement Regulation in effect from 16 January 2023 Gazette Notice No. 47452 dated 04 November 2022.

Responsive Tenders will be scored for functionality first and only those tenders that meet the specified minimum total score for functionality (60%) will be considered further. Tenderers will be evaluated for functionality based on the following criteria.
